Cappadocia has been on the Unesco World Heritage list since 1985 and its historical texture is preserved.

The history of the first people who settled in the region dates back to the Paleolithic Age. Cappadocia, which was uninhabitable for a while due to the destruction caused by active volcances, once again welcomed humanity as it entered the Neolithic Age. As a result of archaeological studies, we can see how old the history of Cappadocia is from the stone tools remaining from the Neolithic Age.

ÜÇ GÜZELLER

The Legend of the Üç Güzeller, one of the most important symbols of Ürgüp Cappadocia, takes its name from an interesting love story.

UÇHİSAR CASTLE

In addition to its mystical beauty, it is one of the most important places to watch the sunset view. The visual feast that emerges as the valleys surrender to the glow of the evening makes Uçhisar a unique spot of romance. For this reason, Uçhisar Castle is always at the top of the list of places to visit in Cappadocia.

DOVECOTE VALLEY

The nests carved into the rocks for pigeons in the valley, which stands out with its magnificent view that creates a fascinating effect on every visitor, continue to host many pigeon species today.



GÖREME OPEN AIR MUSEUM

It is the Cappadocia museum that attracts the most attention. In Göreme, where there are many places of worship, the texture of each church and monastery varies depending on their period. The Göreme region, which was the retreat of past thinkers and monks, was also the land that inspired St. Basil the Great.



DERVENT VALLEY

The resemblance of fairy chimneys to animals takes everyone on a dreamlike, fantastic journey. You can see the fairy chimneys, which resemble many animal figures, as if you were visiting a zoo. The giant camel-shaped fairy chimney is one of the most important symbols of the valley. It is also possible to see humanlike figures in the valley where you will witness nature's sculpture art.



AVANOS

It is one of the most visited places in Cappadocia and is popular for its pottery, Swinging Bridge and Kızılırmak.

LAVANTA PANAROMA

An ideal renewal point to enjoy coffee accompanied by the fascinating view of Ortahisar Castle in the heart of Cappadocia.

KAYMAKLI UNDERGROUND CITY

Kaymakli, one of the important underground cities of Cappadocia, consists of 8 floors. It has astonishing sections such as warehouses, kitchens, cemeteries, kitchens and copper workshops. It contains secret underground tunnels that have still not been fully uncovered.

ONIX STONE WORKSHOP

Onyx stone, known as the stone of separation and luck, is a semi-precious stone type. This stone is actually gray and black in color and has light color bands. This stone, which has an opaque appearance, is as shiny as glass. Onyx stone, which is used in the production of many decorative and daily use objects, can be used in ashtrays, candle holders, candlesticks, vases, key chains, chess sets, all kinds of jewelry and many other items.
